



Transparency in Coverage Rule

Effective July 1, 2022, the Transparency in Coverage rule requires most group health plans to provide publicly available machine-readable files that include in-network negotiated payment rates and historical out-of-network charges for covered items and services, including prescription drugs. This rule is designed to help patients know how much their health care will cost in advance of treatment.
